2026 POOL SEASON

The 2026 pool season will soon be here! Due to the increase in utilities (water and electricity), the Board of Directors has approved for the pool pass prices to increase by \$5. The price goes up an additional \$5 as of May 1st. If you are a tenant, your landlord must provide a copy of your lease to obtain pool passes and your landlord and homeowners must be current in your dues to get passes. For new pool passes, you must also provide pictures for each person getting pool passes (picture the size of a business card or smaller). If you have your 2025 passes, please submit them with your payment.

Before April 30, 2026:

0-4 years of age:	NO CHARGE
5-12 years of age:	\$15.00
13 years—Adult:	\$25.00
Guest Pool Pass:	\$40.00
Daily Rate:	\$13.00

As of May 1, 2026 the cost will be:

0-4 years of age:	NO CHARGE
5-12 years of age:	\$20.00
13 years—Adult:	\$30.00
Guest Pool Pass:	\$45.00
Daily Rate:	\$13.00

2026 POOL PASSES STICKERS AVAILABLE!

We are happy to announced that the 2026 pool stickers are available for purchase. If you have your 2025 pool passes from last year, you can drop them off with the new payment amount and a 2026 sticker will be put on your pass.

Remember, this is the first pool pass increase in 27 years!!!!!! But due to the increase in water and electricity costs, the Board of Directors had to increase the fees to a nominal increase. We are still the lowest price pool passes in this area.

GREEN MOLD ON HOMES AND REAR FENCES

Over the winter months, green mold has developed on a lot of the houses and rear fences. This must be one of your early spring tasks to be taken care of. We are requesting to have this work done by the end of March, weather permitting. Thereafter, notices will be sent to all homes that need this work to be completed and a one time 7 day extension will be given. So please do an inspection of your siding and fence to assure compliance. You can look up power washing companies online and schedule an appointment in advance. Failure to comply may result in a fine being assessed until the violation is corrected. We don't want to do that, but only if necessary. So please make arrangements to have it done. Also, make sure your front and rear yard is clean. They will also be inspected. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
